THIS CAUSE comes before the Court upon the State's "Motion for Reconsideration of Post-Trial Bond," filed March 7, 2024. Upon consideration of the motion and the record, and being otherwise fully advised in the premises, it is

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that:

- I. The State's motion is hereby **GRANTED**.
- II. The Order Reducing Bond entered on March 6, 2024, is hereby VACATED and **SET ASIDE**. See Florida Rule of Criminal Procedure 3.550 ("If a verdict of guilty is rendered the defendant shall, if in custody, be remanded.") (emphasis added). "While an accused has a right to bail before trial, except for capital offenses where the proof is evident or the presumption great, after conviction this right no longer exists. The withdrawal of this right is not illogical. Justice for any individual contemplates full enjoyment of his constitutional rights, but when such individual commits and is convicted of a crime, then justice to society requires him to be punished. Those rights theretofore enjoyed, such as the right to liberty

the continued peace and safety of all organized society." Baker v. State, 213 So.

III. The previously set bail/bond, in the amount of \$5,000.00, is hereby **REVOKED**

and Defendant is remanded to the custody of the Alachua County Department of

Corrections pending disposition with bail/bond set at **NO BOND**.

IV. The Alachua County Clerk of Court shall immediately issue a capias for NO

BOND for Defendant.
