COUNT II: AND WHEREAS the complaint further alleged that Brandon Rachard Hines, in Alachua County, Florida, on or about December 4, 2024, did unlawfully commit a battery upon O'Shala Michelle Graham by actually and intentionally touching or striking said person against said person's will or intentionally causing bodily harm to said person, by punching the victim and/or pulling the hair of the victim and/or shoving the victim, and at that time Brandon Rachard Hines and O'Shala Michelle Graham met the definition of a family or household member, contrary to Sections 784.03(1) and 741.28, Florida Statutes.
