- 1 MR. NAGEL: All right. So we are recording.
- 2 This is Ryan Nagel with the State Attorney's Office. I'm
- 3 here with Detective Bernal with the Gainesville Police
- 4 Department. Also present is Deborah Hunt, from regional
- 5 counsel. And we are here with Timmie Rowe on the case of
- 6 Dallvion Parker.
- 7 Mr. Rowe, your name was provided as a potential
- 8 witness in this case involving Mr. Parker, so Detective
- 9 Bernal is here to ask you some questions. I may follow
- 10 up with some other questions, if I have any. Your
- 11 attorney is present because you do have charges of your
- 12 own. They're unrelated to this case, so I don't think
- 13 we're gonna get into anything about your cases or what
- 14 you're in the jail for. But in case we start to get
- 15 close to it, Ms. Hunt is here, and she could interject.
- Also, as an officer of the court, I'm here to
- 17 make sure that you don't accidentally start talking about
- 18 your case or anything like that. I haven't looked into
- 19 your charges. I don't even know who the prosecutor is.
- 20 I think that Detective Bernal mentioned that it might be
- 21 something domestic. I might even be the prosecutor on
- 22 the case. But that's to show you that I haven't even
- 23 looked into it.
- So the only thing I'm going to do first is
- 25 swear you in. Now, one of the things I do want to tell

- 1 you, because you are here, is that in giving this
- 2 testimony, I want you to understand that the State is
- 3 making no promises that it's going to positively affect
- 4 your case in any way. You know, I'm not making any
- 5 promises of any consideration or anything of that nature.
- 6 Really we're taking your testimony as a potential witness
- 7 in the case.
- 8 And so I want to be clear that anything that
- 9 you're telling us is done freely and voluntarily. We are
- 10 here without a subpoena, so you don't technically have to
- 11 talk to us. However, as a witness, it's possible that
- 12 the state could subpoena you in the future about this
- 13 case.
- MR. ROWE: Okay.
- MR. NAGEL: Do you have any questions for me
- 16 before we get started?
- 17 (No verbal response.)
- 18 MR. NAGEL: I'm going to swear you in. Raise
- 19 your right hand. Do you swear or affirm that the
- 20 testimony you're about to provide is the truth, the whole
- 21 truth, and nothing but the truth, so help you, God?
- MR. ROWE: Yes, sir.
- MR. NAGEL: All right. Detective Bernal, you
- 24 can go ahead and start.
- DETECTIVE BERNAL: Okay. Hey, Timmie. Again,

- 1 I may be repeating some of the questions that either
- 2 Detective Meek or Detective Dose asked you previously,
- 3 but I just have what they told me from the meeting with
- 4 you, and I like to make sure I understand just talking to
- 5 you face to face.
- 6 Okay. So my understanding is you knew
- 7 Brittany.
- 8 MR. ROWE: I knew her for a long time.
- 9 DETECTIVE BERNAL: Tell me about that. Tell me
- 10 about Brittany.
- MR. ROWE: I mean, she would -- she was -- she
- 12 was five personalities in one person. She was joyful,
- 13 like full of life. I mean, even if she went through a
- 14 bad scene, whatever she went through, she wouldn't even,
- 15 like, let it be shown because she always keeps smiling on
- 16 some positive aspect of it.
- DETECTIVE BERNAL: Yeah. Yeah. A lot of
- 18 people have (indiscernible).
- MR. ROWE: I miss her, though. I miss her,
- 20 though.
- 21 DETECTIVE BERNAL: You miss her. I'm so sorry
- 22 for your loss. And we're doing everything we can to get
- 23 her justice, okay?
- 24 MR. ROWE: I found out -- I found out a couple
- of days after by my homeboy called me and asked me about

- 1 it. I was like, nah. So I end up swinging by there,
- 2 and when I pulled up, I seen the yellow tape, like,
- 3 ripped down. So it was after the scene. Then I'm
- 4 sitting there looking, and I seen the landlord come up.
- 5 And I was like, somebody here? I see her eyes. I'm
- 6 like, so it's true. She's like, yeah. Then on my end, I
- 7 (indiscernible) like, damn, that's crazy.
- 8 DETECTIVE BERNAL: What was your relationship
- 9 with Brittany?
- 10 MR. ROWE: I'm a friend friend. Like, I'm a
- 11 benefit friend, friend with benefits.
- 12 DETECTIVE BERNAL: I gotcha. Okay. How long
- 13 have you known her?
- MR. ROWE: Probably about eight years, nine
- 15 years, something like that.
- 16 DETECTIVE BERNAL: Eight years. So you know
- 17 her.
- MR. ROWE: I know her, know her.
- 19 DETECTIVE BERNAL: What had been going on with
- 20 her? I know that she had a current boyfriend, Al. I
- 21 know a little bit about him. But tell me about what had
- 22 been going on. I know there's maybe some rocky romantic
- 23 stuff going on for a couple months.
- MR. ROWE: I'm gonna take you back to around,
- 25 like, November, December.

- 1 DETECTIVE BERNAL: Okay.
- 2 MR. ROWE: That's when I say I'm a friend
- 3 friend. It was like, okay, (indiscernible). I'm sitting
- 4 in the house. I didn't know about Dallvion at the time,
- 5 but, I mean, I've known him since middle school, but I
- 6 didn't know him. Like I grew up with him. We just knew
- 7 each other from middle school.
- 8 So I'm sitting in the house, and I've been with
- 9 her all day, all day from, like, noon, like, all day,
- 10 morning to -- morning to night, all day. And we
- 11 chilling. So put this in perspective, she called him and
- 12 tell him that she having a girl's night out, right? So
- 13 he ain't coming. So when he do come that night, I'm
- 14 sitting in the house, and (indiscernible). You feel me?
- 15 She in the shower, in the bathroom. He come in with some
- 16 bills and shit, and he put him down. She was like, what
- 17 the fuck? He look at me crazy. Basically, he walked in
- 18 on us. Well, not walked in on us actually, but he walked
- 19 in on us.
- So he put the bill down by the refrigerator.
- 21 Because like this is how her house is, like, when you
- 22 come through, you got the table right here, the kitchen
- 23 right here. You got the long couch right here. You had
- 24 the refrigerator right here.
- So he puts -- he put the bills down, he reach

- 1 up, grabs something off the shelf, because, you know,
- 2 it's like a shelf here. He grabs something from the
- 3 shelf. Then when he do that, I get up, I
- 4 (indiscernible). I get up out of there. But when I
- 5 leave, I go outside and I wait. And he come outside, he
- 6 get in the car, and he, like, double back. So when I
- 7 seen him double back, the second time he leave out,
- 8 that's when I leave. That's the first time.
- 9 Second time we in the house chilling. It's me
- 10 and her, some other dude. I don't know him. So Dallvion
- 11 walk in. Now we do the introduction to each other. So,
- 12 like, hold on, let me talk to you or whatever. So we sit
- down, we talking. And his face, you can see his face,
- 14 like, the aggression, just his demeanor. So we talk,
- 15 whatever. I leave. I get him in the comfort zone to the
- 16 point where I can leave. That's the second time.
- The third time, it's nighttime. I'm sitting in
- 18 the truck. I'm sitting in the truck like this. I'm in
- 19 the (indiscernible) seat. She's standing at the
- 20 passenger seat. Now, I don't know where he came from. I
- 21 didn't hear him walk up. I ain't see him. But he heard
- 22 everything this girl was telling me that she wanted me to
- 23 do to her, etcetera. You feel me?
- 24 DETECTIVE BERNAL: I got you.
- MR. ROW: All right. Back to the second part.

- 1 She didn't want him there.
- DETECTIVE BERNAL: Yeah.
- 3 MR. ROWE: She didn't want him there. Like,
- 4 yeah, she didn't want him there, but it's the third time
- 5 he came up out of nowhere. So I don't know what
- 6 happened, but she basically told me, yeah, it's an
- 7 emotional thing.
- 8 The next thing you know, I ain't heard from --
- 9 I ain't heard from him. I ain't heard from him. I guess
- 10 they spit up or whatever. But he had a key to the house
- 11 because that's how he came in the first, second time. He
- 12 had a key to the house.
- DETECTIVE BERNAL: That's how he came in the
- 14 first and second time?
- MR. ROWE: Yeah.
- 16 DETECTIVE BERNAL: Did you get the impression
- 17 that all three of these times she didn't know he was
- 18 coming?
- 19 MR. ROWE: I know for a fact she didn't know.
- 20 Because the first time she told me (indiscernible) girl's
- 21 night. The second time we chilling, he just popped up.
- 22 The third time, he just came out of nowhere, like,
- 23 literally out of nowhere.
- 24 DETECTIVE BERNAL: Yeah.
- MR. ROWE: And he heard all that, like. He was

- 1 feeling hurt.
- 2 DETECTIVE BERNAL: Yeah. Tell me -- tell me
- 3 why you say that.
- 4 MR. ROWE: Why his feelings hurt?
- 5 DETECTIVE BERNAL: Yeah.
- 6 MR. ROWE: Okay. This supposed to be your
- 7 girl, right? Y' all going -- everybody go through
- 8 things, but you sitting and hear your girl telling the
- 9 next man what she want him to do to her.
- 10 DETECTIVE BERNAL: Yeah.
- MR. ROWE: You feel what I'm saying?
- 12 DETECTIVE BERNAL: Yeah.
- MR. ROWE: So, yeah. (Indiscernible) was
- 14 putting him on the back burner.
- DETECTIVE BERNAL: Yeah. Did she talk to you
- 16 about him? Like, when they had split up or anything
- 17 about him and how he acted?
- 18 MR. ROWE: No. See, this the thing about it, I
- 19 got an ex homeboy, a previous homeboy who used to go with
- 20 her. See, this how I put it together. If my ex
- 21 girlfriend, even if I was with her three years ago,
- 22 couple years ago, whatever, and I find out she got killed
- 23 or whatever, I feel some type of way.
- 24 DETECTIVE BERNAL: Yeah.
- MR. ROWE: I got an ex homeboy who used to deal

- 1 with her, who used to go with her. So I called him, and
- 2 I hear his voice, the sorrowness, the sadness or
- 3 whatever. So as all this going on, I'm talking to the
- 4 landlord. So I asked her, like, (indiscernible). Like,
- 5 y'all ain't heard from him? They're just like
- 6 nonchalant, like, nah, we ain't heard from him or
- 7 nothing. Now, (indiscernible) been a month. It's only
- 8 been a month. You feel me? It ain't even been a whole
- 9 month yet since they, quote, unquote, official broke up
- 10 or going through it or whatever. So I'm like, that just
- 11 didn't sound right to me.
- 12 DETECTIVE BERNAL: Right.
- MR. ROWE: So that's (indiscernible) his name.
- 14 And this is where we at now.
- DETECTIVE BERNAL: Yeah. And then did you get
- 16 to see the video that we had posted?
- MR. ROWE: I saw it on YouTube.
- 18 DETECTIVE BERNAL: Okay. Tell me about that.
- MR. ROWE: So I'm looking at -- I'm looking at
- 20 his build, right? But also I'm looking at his shoes,
- 21 because he had some shoes. I look at shoes.
- 22 DETECTIVE BERNAL: Yeah.
- MR. ROWE: Yeah. I ain't never seen
- 24 (indiscernible). So when (indiscernible), I'm like, I'm
- 25 telling you, I saw them shoes before. They look like

- 1 some Adidas or something like that.
- 2 DETECTIVE BERNAL: Okay. Tell me about what
- 3 they looked like.
- 4 MR. ROWE: They had -- they had white stripes
- 5 going down on the side of them. On the side of them, you
- 6 feel me?
- 7 DETECTIVE BERNAL: Yeah.
- 8 MR. ROWE: So that's why I say they looked like
- 9 Adidas. Plus, I know how he is -- how big he is, and I
- 10 know the walk with it.
- 11 DETECTIVE BERNAL: What about his walk stands
- 12 out?
- MR. ROWE: He walk straight up with his chest
- 14 pulled out a (indiscernible).
- DETECTIVE BERNAL: Yeah.
- MR. ROWE: You feel me?
- 17 DETECTIVE BERNAL: Okay.
- MR. ROWE: Plus, I just (indiscernible),
- 19 like -- I don't know. It's just, you know when you know
- 20 something, you feel me? Yeah.
- 21 DETECTIVE BERNAL: Okay. When that first
- incident, when he went out and you said he doubled back
- in his car, what was he driving?
- 24 MR. ROWE: It was a black -- I want to say --
- 25 what it was. It was a black -- I don't want to say it

- 1 was (indiscernible). I know he got -- he had a truck,
- 2 too.
- 3 DETECTIVE BERNAL: Was this a truck or a car?
- 4 MR. ROWE: This is a car. But he also drive
- 5 a -- he drive a truck too, but it (indiscernible).
- 6 DETECTIVE BERNAL: Okay. But this time he was
- 7 in a black car?
- 8 MR. ROWE: Yeah. I want to say
- 9 (indiscernible).
- 10 DETECTIVE BERNAL: Okay. And each of these
- 11 times, you know, I mean, you're saying she hurt his
- 12 feelings. You know, he's finding you over there more
- 13 than once, right, so he knows you're competition. Did he
- 14 say anything to you?
- 15 MR. ROWE: I see it in his eyes. The second
- 16 time -- the first time, there was no introduction. Like,
- 17 he walked in, I got (indiscernible). I got up out of
- 18 there. Then the second time he walked in, she was like,
- 19 what you doing here? Like, she got disturbed and
- 20 whatever. Like, what you doing here? And I like -- he
- 21 was like, who this is, you know, this and that. I was
- 22 like, shit, I'm (indiscernible) back to back
- 23 (indiscernible), I mean like two times in a week. Like,
- 24 the first and second time happened in one week.
- 25 DETECTIVE BERNAL: The first and second time

- 1 were in one week?
- 2 MR. ROWE: Yeah.
- 3 DETECTIVE BERNAL: But would he say anything to
- 4 you?
- 5 MR. ROWE: (indiscernible) whole conversation
- 6 at the same time. When I say the conversation, I mean, I
- 7 (indiscernible). I seen how he looked mad. And I was
- 8 like, oh, yeah, I'm T. Rowe. So he was like, oh, you T.
- 9 Rowe? I'm like, yeah. And we sat there and drunk a beer
- 10 and stuff together.
- 11 DETECTIVE BERNAL: But you said --
- MR. ROWE: I don't even drink beer, but I told
- 13 him the situation (indiscernible) like drinking beer.
- DETECTIVE BERNAL: Yeah, but you said he seemed
- 15 mad?
- MR. ROWE: Yeah.
- DETECTIVE BERNAL: Yeah. What -- tell me about
- 18 that.
- MR. ROWE: When I said mad, you can see his
- 20 forehead, like, his veins in his forehead coming out and
- 21 stuff like that.
- 22 DETECTIVE BERNAL: Yeah.
- MR. ROWE: That's fucked up (indiscernible).
- 24 DETECTIVE BERNAL: But did Brittany say if he'd
- 25 ever caught someone besides you there with her?

- 1 MR. ROWE: No, she never said nothing like
- 2 that. I had (indiscernible) saying, I didn't know they
- 3 was together.
- 4 DETECTIVE BERNAL: Yeah. Do you know anything
- 5 about someone breaking her door or kicking in her door?
- 6 MR. ROWE: Her door was already broke, from my
- 7 understanding.
- 8 DETECTIVE BERNAL: Yeah. Do you know how it
- 9 got broken?
- 10 MR. ROWE: Oh, he came in (indiscernible) did
- 11 it.
- 12 DETECTIVE BERNAL: He did that?
- MR. ROWE: Hell, yeah.
- 14 DETECTIVE BERNAL: He's the one who broke in
- 15 her door.
- MR. ROWE: He (indiscernible).
- 17 DETECTIVE BERNAL: Was that when you were
- 18 there?
- 19 MR. ROWE: No. This is like when I left.
- 20 DETECTIVE BERNAL: Okay.
- 21 MR. ROWE: The bottom of the door, because --
- 22 she had a regular lock. At the bottom she had like
- 23 (indiscernible) -- at the bottom of the door she had
- 24 like -- what that shit called? It's a lock though.
- 25 DETECTIVE BERNAL: Like a deadbolt?

- 1 MR. ROWE: No. It's like a latch you slide
- 2 over, one of them type of locks, you feel me?
- 3 DETECTIVE BERNAL: Yeah.
- 4 MR. ROWE: I asked him what the fuck happened
- 5 to the door. And that's when I heard about the argument
- 6 with them. (indiscernible) had an argument with him.
- 7 DETECTIVE BERNAL: When was that compared to
- 8 the first, second or third time?
- 9 MR. ROWE: All right. Where we at, February?
- 10 She died in January. It was like late December.
- DETECTIVE BERNAL: Okay. So he broke in her
- 12 door in late December?
- MR. ROWE: Yeah.
- 14 DETECTIVE BERNAL: And you said it was during
- 15 an argument. Did she tell you what that was about?
- MR. ROWE: She didn't want him no more.
- 17 DETECTIVE BERNAL: She didn't want him to come
- 18 over?
- MR. ROWE: No, she didn't want him no more,
- 20 like it's over with.
- 21 DETECTIVE BERNAL: Oh, okay. Okay. Trying to
- 22 think. Anything else about him that just kind of stood
- out or that you remember him saying to you or to her?
- MR. ROWE: No. He was gonna fuck her up
- 25 though.

- 1 DETECTIVE BERNAL: What was that?
- 2 MR. ROWE: He was gonna fuck her up.
- 3 DETECTIVE BERNAL: He said he was going to fuck
- 4 her up?
- 5 MR. ROWE: Yeah.
- 6 DETECTIVE BERNAL: Okay. What time --
- 7 MR. ROWE: This is the third time right here.
- 8 This is the time when she hurt his feelings, when he
- 9 heard her saying what she wanted me to do to her.
- 10 DETECTIVE BERNAL: And when was this third
- 11 time?
- MR. ROWE: This is like December.
- 13 (indiscernible) It was late December, I believe.
- 14 DETECTIVE BERNAL: You said you've known of him
- 15 at least since middle school?
- MR. ROWE: Yeah, we went to middle school
- 17 together. After that, I ain't heard from him until we
- 18 had an introduction with each other.
- 19 DETECTIVE BERNAL: Okay. Did you ever know him
- 20 to carry a qun?
- MR. ROWE: Nah. But he grabbed a pistol when
- 22 he had -- like first when he walked in. When he put the
- 23 bills down, he grabbed some weed and he got the pistol
- 24 there. That's what I left.
- DETECTIVE BERNAL: Okay. That was what was on

- 1 top of the fridge, was a pistol?
- 2 MR. ROWE: And weed. Not on top -- not on top
- 3 of the fridge.
- 4 DETECTIVE BERNAL: Okay.
- 5 MR. ROWE: It's a shelf.
- 6 DETECTIVE BERNAL: On the shelf?
- 7 MR. ROWE: It's the refrigerator -- it's the
- 8 stove, refrigerator, and it was a shelf.
- 9 DETECTIVE BERNAL: Okay. Did you see the
- 10 pistol?
- MR. ROWE: Hell yeah.
- 12 DETECTIVE BERNAL: What did it look like?
- MR. ROWE: I want to say like a -- it was
- 14 black, between a 9 and a .40, something like that.
- 15 DETECTIVE BERNAL: Semi-auto?
- MR. ROWE: I don't know.
- 17 DETECTIVE BERNAL: You don't know?
- 18 MR. ROWE: Yeah. I just saw -- I just saw him
- 19 grab it like this.
- 20 DETECTIVE BERNAL: Okay.
- MR. NAGEL: I think, when Detective Burnal says
- 22 semi-auto, do you know the difference between like a
- 23 semi-auto or a revolver?
- MR. ROWE: It wasn't a revolver.
- MR. NAGEL: So it's one that, like, would have

- 1 a slide that you would pull back?
- 2 MR. ROWE: Yeah.
- 3 MR. NAGEL: Okay.
- 4 DETECTIVE BERNAL: I know you were able to look
- 5 at the lineup last time with Dose and me, so I appreciate
- 6 that. I turned off the light on you.
- 7 Anything else that they asked you then, or
- 8 anything that you have questions about for me?
- 9 MR. ROWE: Not really. That's just crazy how
- 10 it all happened, though.
- 11 DETECTIVE BERNAL: Yeah. Was there something
- 12 else? Because I thought Meek had said maybe you were
- 13 wanting to talk to me again or talk to us again.
- MR. ROWE: No, no, that was it. I wanted to
- 15 see what was going on.
- 16 DETECTIVE BERNAL: Okay. I didn't know if
- 17 something maybe had popped into your head since you got
- 18 to talk to them.
- MR. ROWE: No.
- 20 DETECTIVE BERNAL: Okay.
- 21 MR. NAGEL: Did you know -- I know we talked a
- 22 lot about Brittany. Did you know any of the other guys?
- 23 Let's start with Trayvon. Did you know him?
- MR. ROWE: Yeah, I know him.
- MR. NAGEL: How did you know him?

- 1 MR. ROWE: That's Alomanz nephew.
- 2 MR. NAGEL: Say that again?
- 3 MR. ROWE: That's his nephew.
- 4 MR. NAGEL: Trayvon was your nephew?
- 5 MR. ROWE: No. It's Alamonz nephew, I think.
- 6 MR. NAGEL: Okay. And who's Alamonz?
- 7 MR. ROWE: That's the -- she didn't go with
- 8 Alamonz. She just babysit his baby.
- 9 MR. NAGEL: Had you ever seen him at Brittany's
- 10 house before?
- 11 MR. ROWE: Uhn-uhn. (Indiscernible) me and
- 12 Trayvon was over there.
- MR. NAGEL: Sorry, I said "him." Had you seen
- 14 Trayvon at Brittany's house before?
- MR. ROWE: Yeah.
- MR. NAGEL: Okay. But you never seen --
- MR. ROWE: Alomanz in there.
- MR. NAGEL: How do you spell -- is that A-L-A-
- $19 \quad M-O-N?$
- MR. ROWE: I would say, yeah.
- 21 DETECTIVE BERNAL: There's a Z at the end, too,
- 22 maybe.
- 23 MR. NAGEL: Okay. Was he -- was Trayvon ever
- 24 at Brittany's house during those three times that you
- 25 mentioned that --

- 11 (indiscernible) a little bit. But he wasn't hearing that
- 12 shit. Yeah, he wasn't hearing that shit. It started
- 13 like, what the fuck, bitch. (Indiscernible) I'm telling
- 14 you. You got me fucked up. I'm like, man, what the
- 15 fuck? (Indiscernible) So I called my people to come get
- 16 me.
- MR. NAGEL: Have you heard anybody around the
- 18 pod or anything talking about Dallvion or the murder?
- MR. ROWE: No. I didn't know he got caught
- 20 until, like, I came in here or they had been talking to
- 21 me. I found out, like -- matter of fact, I just found
- 22 out last week. Yeah, they (indiscernible).
- DETECTIVE BERNAL: He went up there, yeah.
- MR. ROWE: Yeah. But how I know that?
- DETECTIVE BERNAL: How do you know that?

- 1 MR. ROWE: You see what (indiscernible)? How I
- 2 know that?
- 3 MR. NAGEL: That's what we're asking you.
- 4 MR. ROWE: That's why I'm trying to tell Meeks.
- 5 I like Meeks. Listen, I'm very well -- hold on, let me
- 6 phrase this. I used to be heavy in the streets. So you
- 7 gotta understand, like, when I say heavy in the streets,
- 8 I mean, I be deep in the streets. So I get more
- 9 information than y'all get over like --
- 10 DETECTIVE BERNAL: Yeah. Can we go -- can we
- 11 pause this for a second?
- MR. NAGEL: Yeah. Hold on one second.
- 13 (A brief pause.)
- 14 All right. So we took a brief pause. We are
- 15 back on the recording. Still present is Deb Hunt,
- 16 Regional Counsel, Mr. Rowe, Detective Bernal, Ryan Nagel,
- 17 State Attorney's Office.
- MS. HUNT: And for the record, I would
- 19 encourage you, Mr. Rowe, to discuss the details of the
- 20 different incidents you know about with Detective Bernal
- 21 and Mr. Nagle.
- MR. ROWE: Yeah.
- MS. HUNT: It is my advice that, as long as it
- 24 doesn't involve anything involving you, that you speak
- 25 about what you know.
