NARRATIVE

1. AO: On 12/1/23, at approximately 1100 hours, I responded to [REDACTED], in reference to suspicious activity. I was in uniform driving a marked patrol vehicle. My body worn camera was activated during this call.

2. INV: Upon arrival I made contact with [REDACTED] who is the mother of [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] is a [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] said that she ordered an UBER ride for [REDACTED] destined for [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] said that [REDACTED] texted her during the UBER drive stating that the UBER driver was not going the right way.

█████ said that she told the UBER driver that the way he was driving was wrong but stated that the UBER driver insisted that his map was taking him the correct way. █████ said the driver took her to a yellow house and then dropped her off at the Office Depot store off of NW 13th St. █████ said she waited at the Office Depot for her mother.

██████████ provided me with the UBER order information. Driver's name was Carlos and the listed vehicle for this particular ride was a silver Nissan Versa bearing FL TAG ██████████

I ran the tag number in MCT and found that the registered owner lived at [REDACTED] Carlos was not listed as the registered owner but was listed under the registered owners emergency contact information.

I left the listed location and made contact with Carlos at the [REDACTED] address. The vehicle listed was parked in front of apt [REDACTED]. Carlos answered the door and I informed him I was there to speak about the UBER drive from earlier in the morning. Carlos quickly said that yes he took a juvenile for the requested UBER ride. Carlos said he would grab his phone to show me the map that UBER showed for the ride. I viewed the UBER map and it shows a route to the area of Office Depot on NW 13th St. Carlos said that the directions actually took him to a house but he didn't feel comfortable leaving a juvenile there since clearly it was the wrong destination. Carlos said that he took [REDACTED] to the Office Depot store and stated that [REDACTED] said that her mom was coming to get her.

I told Carlos that he did the right thing taking [REDACTED] to a safe location to wait for [REDACTED]. I informed Carlos that there was no criminal activity reported but that [REDACTED] did request this incident to be recorded. I told Carlos this was just an informational report. I asked Carlos for his full name and date of birth. Carlos' demeanor immediately changed. He became upset with me and hostile. I attempted to deescalate Carlos by explaining thoroughly that I was requesting his information so that I was documenting properly. Carlos refused several times, talking over me, saying that he was not going to give me his information, then asking me several times why I wanted his information. I attempted to explain again why but my efforts failed. I asked Carlos if he would like the case report number for his records or at least for the registered owner's records since I was going to list the vehicle in my report. Carlos denied the case report number but I said I would leave one for the vehicles owner.

I went to my vehicle and retrieved a GPD blue card. When I walked back to Carlos he was now filming me. Carlos refused to take the case report card from me so I left it on top of a dense bush next to where Carlos was standing. I told Carlos to have a good day and got in my vehicle to leave. As I was slowly backing out of the parking space, Carlos walked around my car, about 5 feet from my driver side window. I heard Carlos asking for my badge number so I rolled my window down and told him. I was still slowly backing out when Carlos walked forcefully up to my open window, trying to place his phone, which was still recording, inside my vehicle. Carlos tapped his recording hand on my side mirror and dropped his phone on the ground. Carlos began to scream that I hit him with my vehicle. I got out of my vehicle and requested a supervisor. While waiting for supervisor contact, Carlos, still recording, asked again why I was writing a report and stated that I gave him a ticket. I re-explained to Carlos that the blue card was a piece of paper that has the case report number on it so that he or the registered owner of the vehicle had directions on how to request the official report.

I then got back into my car and called Sergeant Kerkau. I advised Kerkau of what had happened from start to finish. Kerkau advised to leave the area. While I was on the phone with Kerkau, Carlos stood right at my door filming me, he walked to the back of my vehicle and then back to my window. I began to leave the parking lot and Carlos then positioned himself in front of my patrol vehicle, still recording and standing at the very front of my vehicle. I had to slowly maneuver around Carlos to leave the apartment complex.

I was able to identify Carlos from his FL DL after finding his full name from the emergency contact information listed on the registered owners vehicle. I listed him as an involved other, as I did with [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] in this report and updated his information in MCT.

Carlos later arrived at the station and requested to speak to a supervisor. Sergeant Kerkau resonded to the front desk and spoke with him about the incident.

3. EVI: I have pictures of the UBER order from [REDACTED] and Carlos. This was clearly a fluke in the UBER system and there was no crime.
4. SCA: N/A
5. VEH: See listed in narrative.
6. ADD: I turned on my in car camera when trying to leave the complex the second time. I tagged the video under this case report number where it shows Carlos standing in the way of my vehicle.
