N A R R A T I V E	VIC is a 15 year old child. On June 16, 2024 VIC was incarcerated at the Alachua County Juvenile Detention Center (hereinafter, "JDC") and housed in Pod B3. On June 16, 2024 the Co-Def was employed by and on duty at the JDC. Def duty assignment for this day was Pod B3.

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ARREST REPORT (Additional Narrative)

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"J.I.#1") can be seen walking around Pod [REDACTED] at the same time. At 0135 hrs J.I. #1 can be observed on video saying something to several other juvenile inmates in the Pod and then speaking to Vic. Moments later Vic is surrounded by 5 juvenile inmates, including J.I. #1. Co-Def enters the pod, apparently eating, and clearly and obviously able to observe Vic surrounded by the 5 juvenile inmates. However, Co-Def does nothing to de-escalate the situation or interact with the juvenile inmates. Moments later the group of juvenile inmates surrounding Vic attack Vic.

When the attack happens the Co-Def appears to use his radio to communicate something. Co-Def then casually walks over to the juveniles as they continue to attack the Vic. By the time Co-Def is standing next to the group and the Vic, the Vic appears to be unconscious and the attackers are still actively beating the Vic; the Vic is being stomped on and struck by the group. Approximately 10 seconds elapse before the Co-Def tries to pull one of the attacking youth off of the Vic. Co-Def is unsuccessful in pulling the youth away from Vic. Co-Def can be seen backing away; letting go of the youth who he had tried to pull off of Vic and taking a few steps back. The attack goes on for approximately 5 more seconds before the youth stop actively beating and kicking the Vic together. The group partially disperses allowing a better view of Vic on the surveillance video. The Vic is obviously unconscious, lying on the ground.

After another 30 seconds pass before the Vic is able to sit up on his own. No aid or medical treatment is rendered to the Vic and no attempt is made to remove him from Pod [REDACTED]. The Co-Def walks over to the Vic and stands near the Vic. While standing near the Vic the Co-Def allows - does nothing to prevent - one of the juvenile inmates that had just attacked the Vic to get very close to the Vic again and strike the Vic in the face at least 2 more times while the Co-Def stands there and does nothing to intervene or prevent this from occurring.

At around 0138hrs the Co-Def and another JDC employee begin to try and move the Vic out of the area where he was just attacked. The juvenile inmates who had attacked Vic are still walking around the area unrestricted. By this time almost 2 minutes have passed since the initial attack had happened. Video surveillance shows that the Vic finally is being escorted out of the area by Co-Def. However, Vic is walking several feet ahead of Vic who had just been stomped in the head and beaten, losing consciousness. Vic is obviously and apparently not steady on his feet and is made seen carrying his bed mat and blanket with him as he exits while the Co-Def is empty handed (his radio is in his hand but is equipped with a belt clip).

Not only is the Co-Def walking several feet ahead of Vic, not assisting Vic, Vic is made to walk past once of the juvenile inmates that attacked him. As the Vic passes one of the juvenile inmates who had just attacked, the juvenile inmate swings at the Vic to punch him. The punch lands on the mattress the Vic is holding. Finally, Co-Def positions himself between the juvenile inmate who just swung a punch at Vic and Vic.

At around 0139hrs the Vic is finally removed from Pod [REDACTED] and placed in an isolation area. YA has confirmed with JDC records that at this time Vic had still not receive any medical attention of treatment. Investigation has revealed that on June 16, 2024 at the time this attack took place JDC was only staffed by 4 personnel although the minimum staffing for the facility was 8.

Once in the isolation area the Def finally met with and spoke to the Vic. Def, on June 16, 2024,

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was a Major at the JDC, and, accordingly, the highest ranking employee at JDC. Def prepared a statement in her capacity as Major of the JDC regarding the above-described incident. In her official written statement, Def writes that she had personally witnessed the entire fight from the control center of the facility. The Def also states that she spoke to the Vic and observed that he had several scratches and abrasions from the fight and indicates that she "will follow-up with medical in the morning."

YA has learned from speaking to the Def and other JDC employees that it is the policy of the JDC that if a child loses consciousness they are to request EMS to the facility to evaluate the child. YA has confirmed that this was never done. Two days had passed (6-18-24) before the Vic received any type of medical treatment for the injuries he sustained from being attacked on June 16, 2024. It was later learned that the Vic sustained a concussion from the attack. Medical professionals with the Child Protection Team ("CPT") where the Vic was seen on 7-1-24 informed YA that the Vic may have sustained long term effects of the concussion due to not being treated immediately.

Investigation also revealed that neither the Vic's mother nor law enforcement or DCF were notified of the June 16, 2024 attack of Vic until 7-1-24 when the Vic's mother responded to JDC to pick up Vic in accordance with his sentencing and observed that Vic had a "black-eye" from the attack.

Co-Def failed to take action to prevent Vic from being attacked. Co-Def failed to protect the Vic while in a position of care and custody of Vic. Vic failed to intervene after Vic was attacked. Co-Def failed to provide Vic with any medical care or attention. Co-Def's failure to act contributed to Vic being physically attacked and sustain an injury that may have long term effects on the Vic's future health.

The failure to provide/facilitate the necessary medical attention to the Vic by the Def may have also resulted in the Vic having long-term effects on his health.
